





English Language Arts Curriculum

Balanced Literacy:

a balance of whole language and phonics-based instruction

- Five Components:
 - read aloud
 - shared reading
 - guided reading
 - independent reading
 - word study

- Equal attention to reading and writing instruction
 - Reading and writing are interdependent, instruction in one supports learning in the other.
- Interactive and hands-on
- Rotation in Collaborative Groups
- Continually producing writing with editing and revisions

Mathematics Curriculum

Zearn/Eureka: curriculum that includes instructional materials and digital online materials

Differentiation:

materials are aligned, connected, and cover the same concepts in multiple learning platforms

- provides a variety of ways to approach problems
- provides practice for application of problems
- use of manipulatives for great hands-on understanding
- project-based math activities
- online resources available for at home learning and reinforcement






